If we know victims personally, we anticipate their needs and meet them. And, third, we offer the world the hope of the gospel. As I said, the reason heinous acts of violence happen is because our world is broken. Jesus Christ is the only cure for our brokenness. It's only through faith in Him that we can find salvation.

He is ultimately everything we need. I wonder, do you know Jesus today?


